The history of what is known as "Western-style horse racing" in our country is said to have been initiated by foreign residents in the Yokohama settlement. However, the first horse racing event organized by Japanese people took place in 1870 (Meiji 3rd year) at *Tokyo's Kudan Shrine, later known as Yasukuni Shrine*.

Taking this historical background into account, our project has decided to revive the Kudan area as the venue for the "*Kiso-Uma*" horse racing in the virtual space Edoverse. The Kudan district will become the epicenter of the horse racing business in future Edoverse projects, holding the potential for significant value expansion.

In this campaign, we will offer for a limited time the bundled NFT, which includes the business rights for the horse racing project and one of the **2282** plots of land (out of a total of **11414** plots, including Yasukuni Shrine) in the Kudan area.

Horse Owner, Horse Business, Land Ownership Integrated NFT

Stage1.

Breeding Game



- Those who purchase five or more plots of land in the Kudan area will be granted a racehorse NFT and become horse owners.
- As a horse owner, you can lend your horse to a feudal lord (landholder) in the Daimyo Koji or Oote-mon area and entrust them with the horse's upbringing.
- Horses will be raised at the horse stable in the Daimyo residence or Oote-mon area.
- In the Kudan area, a horse fodder store will be established to sell horse feed, and the owners of Kudan area land NFTs can sell horse fodder (food for horses) to the feudal lords responsible for horse breeding.
- There are various methods for raising horses. Feeding them horse fodder and playing games can help nurture them into horses with unique and distinctive characteristics specific to the feudal lord.

Stage2.

Yabusame Game



- **Yabusame** is a traditional Japanese archery practice that involves shooting arrows while riding a galloping horse.
- The raised horses will be useful.
- By entering one's own horse into competitions and winning, prize money can be earned. The prize money will be distributed among the horse owner and the person who raised the horse.
- Further details will be announced in the future.

Stage3.

Kisoi-Uma Game



- "Kisoi-Uma" is an old-fashioned term for horse racing in Japan.
- A portion of the overall revenue from the upcoming race game project will be distributed among the landowners in the Kudan area.

Pre-Application Procedure (For those purchasing with USDC)

1. Please prepare a WALLET such as Metamask. (*Metamask is recommended.)
2. Purchase USDC and send it to your Metamask wallet.
3. By August 10th, please transfer 500 USDC to the following address:

*Note 1: It is not necessary to use Metamask specifically, but it is essential to send the USDC to an address capable of receiving NFTs. For example, sending from an exchange is not allowed. If you are unsure, please make sure to send from Metamask.

*Note 2: If you send the USDC to the wrong address, refunds cannot be processed. Please ensure to copy and paste the destination address accurately.

*Note 3: Once the number of applications reaches the available number of NFTs for sale, the application process will be closed. For those who make purchases after the sale ends, we will process refunds sequentially.

4. Once the payment is confirmed, the NFTs will be transferred to your specified wallet on August 17th.

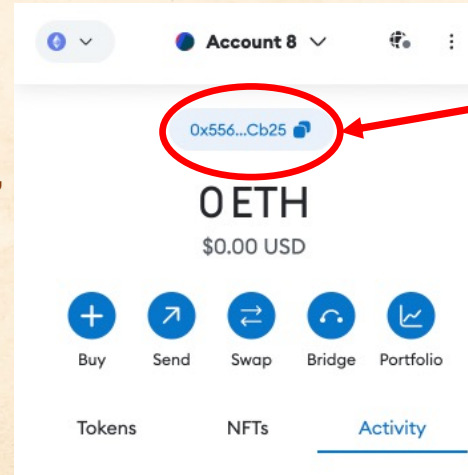
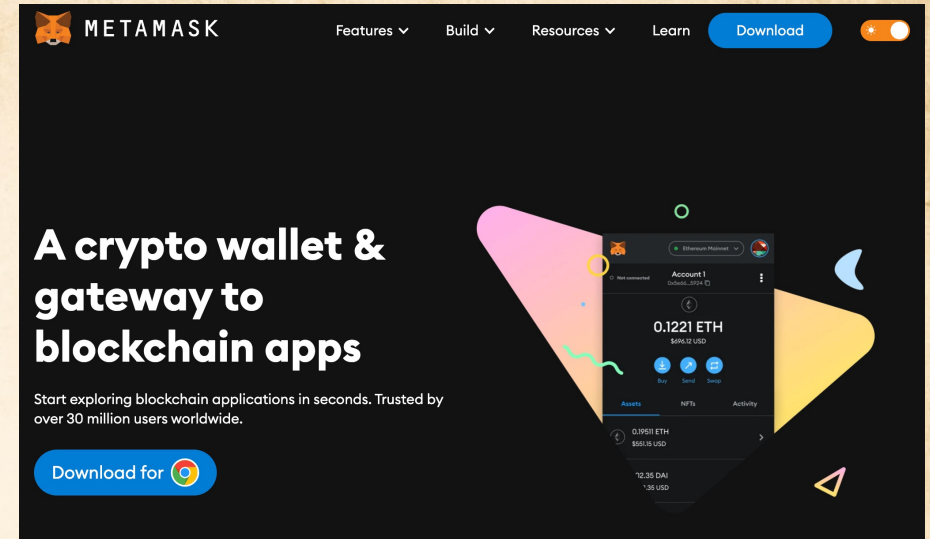
1. Please scan the QR code above and fill in the necessary information (Name, Wallet Address, Email, Bank Account, Desired Number of NFTs) on the Google Form. Please note that any errors in the provided information may invalidate your application.
2. You will receive a confirmation email upon successful registration. Once the number of applications reaches the available number of NFTs for sale, the application process will be closed.
3. Please make the purchase payment to the bank account specified in the completion email by August 13th. (The remittance fee will be borne by the sender.)
4. Once the payment is confirmed, the NFTs will be transferred to your designated wallet on August 17th.
5. If the payment amount received by August 13th is less than the applied purchase amount, or if you make the payment after August 13th, we will refund the amount you sent. (The remittance fee will be borne by the recipient.)
6. You can view the details of the NFTs transferred to your wallet through Etherscan, or easily confirm them on OpenSea. Please refer to the final page for more information.

Download the Wallet

1. Even for purchases in Japanese Yen, you will still need a cryptocurrency wallet to store the NFT.
2. Edoverse ecosystem's NFTs are generated using the Ethereum ERC721 standard, so you will need an Ethereum Mainnet compatible wallet.
3. One of the popular Ethereum Mainnet compatible wallets is MetaMask, so if you don't have a wallet yet, please obtain MetaMask.

4. Please ensure to keep the secret key (recovery phrase) of the wallet created with MetaMask absolutely confidential and store it securely. If you lose the secret key, you will permanently lose access to all the assets in the wallet. The secret key consists of 12 English words that appear during the wallet setup. Be careful not to mix up the order of the words and make sure to enter them correctly.



The text displayed here will be your account address.

By pressing this button, your account address will be copied, so you can paste it when connecting your wallet to the platform.

Confirmation of NFT Transferred to Wallet After Purchase

1. Access the website called "OpenSea" by visiting the following link:

2. Once the OpenSea website appears, click on the "person icon" and then click on the "My Profile" section that appears.

3. Clicking on "My Profile" will bring up the wallet connection screen where you need to enter your password to connect OpenSea with your wallet. After connecting your wallet, a list of the NFTs you own will be displayed.
